

Russian Army Uniforms, ~1709

Regiments are listed by Colonel's name, Guards first, then Grenadiers, then Line units.

Each regiment is also given its 1706 onwards regional designation. Note that spelling varies depending on sources...

Each regiment has two lines of uniform details; the upper one is taken from Höglund, the lower from Konstam.

All information on field colour of regimental standards has been taken from Konstam.

Infantry flags of 1700 pattern were 2.25m high x 2.6m long, 4m long staff painted black. (Höglund)

Dragoon flags of 1700 pattern were 0.9m high x 1.2m long (Höglund)

Pikes were ~3.4m long, painted black.

Preobrasjenski Guards had bombardier detachment of 6 x 6pdr Coehorn mortars and 4 x 3pdr regimental guns.

Semenovski guard had 6 x 3pdrs

Other infantry regiments had 2 x 3pdrs.

At Poltava the artillery train consisted of (Konstam):

68 x 3pdrs (regimental guns)

13 x 2pdrs (horse artillery)

12 x 8pdrs

2 x 12pdrs

1 x 40pdr & 1 x 20pdr howitzer

1 x 20pdr mortar

2 x 40pdr mortars

Konstam indicates that dragoon regiments tried 2 x 2pdr howitzers, with mounted crews.

~ 1707 gun carriages painted green with black metal (Höglund); by 1702 brick red (Konstam)

Wagons had double-headed eagle.
